



• Survey was aimed to get the better understanding of occupational safety within European police organizations.

• Questions were asked about the personal protection equipment, weapons/equipment and clothing (uniform), as well as information on training and retraining.

• It also sheds the light on the psycho-social police workload and the circumstances that it is done under in different European countries.








Q30 Do police officers have any other safety equipments items (bodycams, tasers, etc.)? (yes/no)





Training & Prevention Issues:



• In just a few of the surveyed countries policemen and women, depending on their positions and career advancements, receive additional training in, for example, communications, medical (first aid), IT courses, foreign languages, Schengen regulations, traffic monitoring, documents forging, forensics, etc.

• We have also registered how police officers are being exposed to contagious infectious diseases, especially those working with refugees, and are not provided with vaccinations and proper medical care.

In Conclusion:



• Police officers require personal protection equipment if they are to work in a safe and healthy manner.

• With the results of our research we can confirm that equipment of suitable quality is not always available in the required numbers, especially in Eastern European countries.

• Police officers in Europe have regularly lost their lives or have been heavily wounded due to ineffective or missing equipment.

What is our goal here?

To establish minimum standards for the European police officers when it comes to their Uniforms, Equipment and Training.








Research about acceptance of current issued police footwear in Bulgaria as an example

- October 2017 (4 days)
- 133 officers replied by questionnaire through social media
- 12 officers by F2F interview

Out of the replies, 80% of officers use the official issued police boot, about 20% buy their own boots.







Product Durability


65% of officers report that their official issued police boot is broken within the first 12 months, however only **36%** can replace their boots within the first 12 month – conclusion: a minimum of **29%** perform their daily duty with damaged footwear alrewady in the first year of use.

Even though, **53%** of officers have to use their boots for more than 24 months - out of these **89%** are already damaged or broken.

Product Satisfaction / Security



82% of respondents were not satisfied or not satisfied at all and 80% do not feel secured well enough to preform their daily duty.



Conclusion

These results show:

Current official Police Boot in Bulgaria don't fulfill nowadays requirements and needs policemen and —women have during their daily duty, thus the issued boots do not secure the officers as necessary to perform their job properly and to protect the population in nowadays environments.



EPU's Proposed Minimum Standards on the Police Training & Retraining All police officers should be vaccinated on regular basis against infectious diseases, such as Hepatitis, TBC and other health hazards.

All police officers should be retrained regurarly on:

- Use of firearms (shooting ranges minimum 10hr per year);
- Use of coercive measures/public and self-defense (counter-violence);
- Updates on the regulation changes;
- Driving under extreme circumstances (speed chases and etc);
- Communication & Community Policing



For those who are motivated and able to pursue career advancements, departments should provide additional training in: communications, medical (first aid), IT courses, foreign languages, Schengen regulations, monitoring, documents forging, forensics, etc.
